

What is Taskstream and Why are We Using It?

Taskstream is a customizable, electronic portfolio, assessment management and performance based instruction tool. For National accreditation of our programs, specific student assignments (signature assignments) are to be evaluated based on a faculty developed rubric associated with the InTasc Standards addressed by each assignment.

The electronic submission of the Signature Assignments to Taskstream purpose includes:

1. As college accreditation data collection and storage site, as instructors evaluate each student's Signature Assignments in connection with InTasc performance based outcomes. We must collect and report this data on a regular basis.

Therefore, **EVERY** student taking a Taskstream-designed course is **REQUIRED** to upload and submit their assignment to Taskstream for evaluation (even if only one or two courses are being taken for purposes other than Certificate of Completion, an elective for another degree, personal interest or any other professional purpose).

THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. FAILURE TO COMPLETE TASKSTREAM ASSIGNMENTS ARE GROUNDS FOR RECEIVING A FAILING GRADE FOR THIS COURSE.

After each student submits their Signature Assignments to Taskstream, instructional faculty will use program approved rubrics to evaluate assignments.
